For Submission

Let's dive right in by creating two web pages.

An "About Me" Web Page

Put together a web page about a subject that I am sure you know very well — yourself! Focus on content for now, and not presentation (but don't hesitate to experiment if you are so moved).

Use a variety of elements, organize them in a logical manner, and make sure that your page validates. Your page must include:

- Multiple *a* elements with links to related, favorite, or any other web sites
- At least one *img* element for a picture whose file is supposed to be *on the same web server* as your web page
- At least one list element (*ul* or *ol*)

Feel free to pick and choose anything else that strikes your fancy from the *hellohtml* folder in the sample code bazaar on GitHub.

An "About About Me" Web Page

After putting together the page about yourself, put together another one about what it took to put that page together. While this page should still be a valid web page, it does not have to use as wide a variety of elements as the other one. Instead, focus on producing a write-up that describes your experience with creating the "About Me" page:

- What was easy? Difficult? Fun? Busy work?
- What tools or resources did you like best? Least?
- How do you feel overall about this first foray into creating web content "at the source level?"
