Re: Funds and Timeline for Dream Museum Displays

Funds

Later today I will be transferring 9000 Lindens into each of your SL accounts. The source of these funds is an Interdisciplinary Course Development Grant from the College of Liberal Arts. They are to be used solely for the purpose of helping you construct your displays for the Dream Museum. You will need to document that you followed this guideline by printing out transaction records of anything purchased with this money, and we will show you how to do this. At the end of the semester you will need to submit your documentation for the 9000 Lindens spent. If you have not spent all the money, or you do not submit 9000L in transactions records directly tied to your project costs, you will need to refund the difference by transferring Lindens back into my account. Any student who does not provide 9000L in transaction records directly related to the Dream Museum project, or refund the unused or undocumented portion of the 9000L, will receive an Incomplete for the course until this issue is resolved.

Timeline for completing your Dream Museum displays

March 3	Complete scholarly research on how your assigned culture views and understands dreams. Submit a written summary of what you found (2-5 pages).
March 24	Submit a plan for what you want in your Dream Museum Display based upon your research and how you intend to construct it.
April 14	Submit first version of display for feedback.
April 28	Final version of display submitted for installation in Museum and viewing by class and public.
